

## FROM THE PRINCIPAL

**Mask Mandate** - The State Legislature is planning on voting to repeal the statewide mask mandate. If the statewide mandate is canceled, the City of Green Bay will enact a mask mandate. That means we will continue to wear masks in school. Our athletic league has already decided to continue with the current mask rules for basketball games. Overall, our students are doing an amazing job of wearing masks. We also have been blessed to have very few sick students and no classroom has had to quarantine since September! We ask our Father to continue to bless us with good health and that we can remain in school!

**Wisconsin Parental Choice Program** - Open enrollment for the Wisconsin Parental Choice Program begins on February 1. Students currently enrolled in 3K, 4K, and 5K may be eligible for a voucher. All students currently receiving need a voucher must re-enroll.
