

## FROM THE PRINCIPAL

**Last Day of School:** One week left! Next Thursday, May 21 is our last day. Please stop by St. Paul between 7:30 A.M. and 5:00 P.M. to drop off any school owned supplies that you have (textbooks, library books, etc.), drop off piano books for Mrs. Schultz, and pick up report cards. The closing service will be streamed on YouTube at 9:00 AM.

**Classes:** Over the next week, students will be finishing up projects and daily work at different times. Students can expect to still be in daily contact with their teacher and classes through next Wednesday. The end is in sight! Keep up the faithful work!

**Yearbooks:** Because of COVID-19, Lifetouch, the company that prints our pictures and yearbooks, had to shut down their factory and will not print yearbooks until sometime this summer. Students will be able to pick up their yearbooks when we start school in the fall. Yearbooks for 8th graders will either be sent home with a sibling or mailed to their house. Lifetouch was also unable to print classroom composite photos for this school year.

**Taekwondo Classes:** Do your kids have lots of energy as we enter the last week of school? Join the Zoom taekwondo class for some exercise and fun! Next Monday, May 18 and Wednesday, May 20, at 5:30 P.M., Instructor Daniel Williams from Williams TaeKwonDo in Green Bay is offering free taekwondo classes for St. Paul students. On Sunday, May 24, I will give a short commencement address at the end of the St. Paul online service and will read the names of our graduates. Remember that 60% of those rebates can be applied to next fall's tuition, thereby reducing your balance owed. There is still time to purchase Scrip and get ready for fall!
